A message from our pastor, Rev. Dr. Daniel Wonderly: "Hit the Road"

Dear Members of Faith,

On the day of the Resurrection, two friends were walking along the road to Emmaus. They didn't know, however, that it was Resurrection Day. That's why they were walking along with downcast faces. Then along comes Jesus, who asks: "What is this conversation that you are holding with each other as you walk?"

Then one of them, slightly annoyed, asks Jesus, "Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days?"

Jesus responds: "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" Then Jesus patiently explains the prophecies of Scripture, and how they have been fulfilled by him over the past several years.

Finally, as they eat together, Jesus takes bread, gives thanks, breaks it, and gives it to them. Immediately, their eyes are opened. And without a doubt their mouths were probably hanging open as well, the moment Jesus disappeared from their sight from their physical sight, but not from their hearts and minds. Amazed and excited, the once forlorn disciples return to Jerusalem with a new message: "The Lord has risen indeed!" (Luke 24:34).

We have our opportunities, too, to explain Scripture to the downcast, the bewildered, and the confused. We can come alongside our friends on their "road to Emmaus" and ask what's going on in their lives. And like Jesus, we can remind them of the hope found in the Scriptures. In addition, we can invite them to church where they might have their spiritual eyes opened, see Jesus as their loving Savior, and have their hearts "burn within [them]" (Luke 24:32).

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES 03.13.2024

Our Mission Pillars include: Word & Sacrament; Prayer; Fellowship; Service; Witness.

Opening Prayer: Given by Pastor Dan. Approval of Minutes: Motion made by Pastor Dan to approve minutes as submitted, seconded by Dan Goosen; motion carried. Approval of Treasurer's **Report:** Theresina reports checking is a little low due to time of year, everything is reconciled. On the Financial report, Memorial monies that have been designated will indicate as such and those that are undesignated funds, we will ask the donor if they want it to go towards a particular item. Motion made by Jerry Hallman to approve treasurer's report as submitted, seconded by Lyle motion carried. Pastor's Hackler; Report: Confirmation is on April 14th with 6 students being confirmed this year. Confirmation has been going well and students are currently working on their essays. Pastor will possibly be taking 3 weeks of vacation in June. Capital Campaign: Theresina reports our new balance is: \$189,604.48. \$150,000.00 was designated for roof and carpeting, with \$101,594.84 of that having been spent. Faith Lutheran Youth Report: Camp Luther: There are no girls attending this year. There may be a couple of males and if so, we will need a male chaperone. Next summer is the National Youth Gathering in July. Faith Lutheran Church Survey: Jack went through a congregational survey that is being considered focusing on areas of: Worship Service, Church Family, Serving, and Youth & Family in search of possible changes and/or opinions on the survey before it goes out. Pastor Dan and Jack will talk to Allison Vogels and the Evangelism Team as they expand on the original survey that was drawn up and Council had some possible changes.

M&M Council Responsibilities ∅ Finance/Budget – Theresina Girard-Schmidt, Jack Halbleib: See

Above report. Ø Human Resources – Halbleib: Jack No report. Stewardship/Time & Talents - Kathy Butak: Church Directory: Allison Vogels, Jean & Walt Matchim, and Kathy Butak have been scheduling appointments at all 3 services. Pulpit: Kathy Butak reports she had been contacted by a church in Oklahoma regarding the pulpit but they haven't pursued it further, probably due to distance. Will request that *The Lutheran Witness* print it in the April issue as well. Ø Facilities – Lyle Hackler: Three families at Faith have donated their time and cost for the media booth project and have been diligently working on it. Hopefully it will be installed soon. We have \$800 raised for organ repairs/maintenance so far. Signs will go up to remind members that if they'd like to donate to this cause they may do so. We have been having issues with the screen on the right side and the facilities team has been discussing this. The equipment is outdated, parts are either hard to obtain or unobtainable, and needs to be addressed. We are considering going with a couple of 85" High-Definition TV monitors. Pastor Dan would also like a back wall TV monitor placed near the organ or media booth, and this TV has already been donated. The clarity will be much better on a High-Definition TV versus utilizing screens. Audio Architects are supposed to come next week and look at the current projection system in the meantime to see if something can be done. Lyle reports Post Glass took a couple of leaking windows out of the Narthex to get sizing, quote was \$13,260, however uncertain if this was for frosted windows or clear glass. If frosted are more expensive than clear, then we will go with clear glass. This expense falls under the roofing budget from the Campaign. The "In" sign on the Woodward Avenue entrance will be moved as when driving south it blocks the view of the new LED sign. April 20th is clean-up day starting at 9 AM. We will have hot dogs, chips, etc. Rain date is May 4. Plans are to also clean out the flower area around the LED sign with the Youth Group taking care of replanting. Ø Evangelism - Theresina

Girard-Schmidt: Theresina reports they met today, will be putting out both coffee cups and tumblers at the greeter table. Easter Journey is Saturday, March 23rd at 11 AM. They are working on a clothing fundraiser. Youth will be having a Thrift Sale on May 18th from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. with funds going to Southview Lunch Account. Ø School Pre School/Christian Education/Sunday School - Rachael Simmerman: Jerry Hallman reports May 14 and 15th is Preschool Graduation. Field Trips are planned and enrollment is filling up for next year. Ø Ministry Support – Elders Team - Bill Musser: No Report. Other: Council Staffing Guidelines-Jack Halbleib handed out an updated protocol. Labor of Love Campaign: "A question will be developed to put into the Congregation Survey to explain the Labor of Love Capital Campaign that the NW Wisconsin Synod has developed and seek input into if and how we as a congregation can support this effort. 
